

# how to find us...

## Arrival by car

**Approaching from the South via the M6:** Leave the motorway at junction 15, go left at the roundabout onto the A519 to Newcastle-under-Lyme. Continue on this road crossing two more roundabouts. After about two miles you will descend a hill towards the town, leave the A519 by going slightly left at the bottom of this hill. Go straight on at the traffic lights on the crossroads onto the A525 to Whitchurch. You will cross a roundabout after about one mile and continuing up the hill you will find the University entrance on the left at the top of the rise.

**Approaching from the North via the M6:** Leave the motorway at junction 16, turning right onto the A500 heading towards Nantwich. Continue for about two miles, go left at the roundabout, continue for a further mile and go left at the next roundabout onto the A531 towards Betley. No further road change is required and the Keele University entrance will be reached after approximately eight miles.

**Approaching from the East, using the A50:** Travel along the A50 until it ends just past the 'Britannia' Stoke City football stadium. Turn left (moving into the right-hand lane) and join the A500. Move into a right-hand lane on the A500 to go over the flyover. After about 1 mile turn right at the roundabout onto the A519 to Newcastle-under-Lyme. Continue on this road crossing two more roundabouts.

After about two miles you will descend a hill towards the town, leave the A519 by going slightly left at the bottom of this hill. Go straight on at the traffic lights on the crossroads onto the A525 to Whitchurch. You will cross a roundabout after about one mile and continuing up the hill you will find the University entrance on the left at the top of the rise.

**Approaching from the East through Stoke-on-Trent:** Head for Newcastle-under-Lyme which has a small ring road system. Look for signposting to Whitchurch (A525) and following this you will find the University entrance at the top of the hill.

**Approaching from the West via Crewe/Nantwich:** Use the approach via the A531 passing through Betley and Madeley Heath.

**Approaching from the West from Shrewsbury:** Head for Newcastle-under-Lyme on the A53. Just before entering the town you will pass over the M6 motorway. After about half a mile turn left at the next roundabout. Follow this road to its end, then turn left. Follow this road to the roundabout where you turn left. Keele University entrance is on the left at the top of the hill.

During Degree Days there will be no Pay & Display fee levied.

## Arrival by train

Call **08457 484950** for timetable details. Rail access is by either Stoke-on-Trent or Crewe stations from where regular bus or taxi services provide transport to the University.

## Bus links

**Details from tel: 0870 6082608 or [www.ukbus.co.uk](http://www.ukbus.co.uk) – follow Stoke link:** From Hanley, Stoke-on-Trent railway station and Newcastle-under-Lyme: Service 29 (by 'First') terminates at Keele; service 52 (by 'Arriva') runs between Newcastle and Keele; 'Arriva' service 85 runs between Hanley-Newcastle-Keele-Crewe. From Crewe railway station: via 'Arriva' service 85 (marked to Hanley).

## Arrival by coach

Coaches from all parts of the country call at Hanley or Newcastle-under-Lyme, with bus links (see above) running regularly from both bus stations.

## Arrival by air

Air arrival is usually via Manchester Airport. Then taxi (40 minutes travel time) to Keele, or rail link to Crewe or Stoke and then bus link to Keele (see details above). If via London or Birmingham International airports, rail link to Stoke or Crewe.
