
# HOW TO..... register your module choices on eVision







#### Languages and Intercultural Awareness (Language Specialism)

At level 5 you will continue studying your chosen language with a semester 1 and a semester 2 module.

# Opting Out

#### Thinking of opting out of Global Challenge Pathways?

- If you opt out of a GCP at any level, you cannot choose a GCP module later in your degree programme or choose to opt back in
- To study a GCP and obtain certification, you must study a GCP module (from a single pathway) at levels 4, 5 and 6
- . To opt out, select 'Opt Out and Continue' to progress to the next stage of module enrolment where you can choose from any option modules available to you




Once you have confirmed you wish to continue with your GCP you will see a further confirmation screen which also shows the module that will be added to your student record

This can be extremely useful in helping you make your choices.


Modules will only successfully be added if there are still places available.

Each module has a specific number of designated places set by the School that teaches the module.


Sometimes a module also has a pre-requisite which can be an A-level, some other previous experience / qualification or a module studied at Keele at a previous level.






