MSci Physiotherapy

- 4-year integrated Masters pathway
- Suitable for college / high school leavers, for example, following completion of A levels, International Baccalaureate, STPM with Matriculation (Matrikulasi), Higher Secondary Certificate and others
- Knowledge and skills increases in depth and complexity
- Essential development as a clinician and researcher
 - Clinical education and skills components
 - Development of core research skills

MSc Physiotherapy

- 2-year post-graduate pre-registration Masters pathway
- Suitable for degree holders in an appropriate science or exercise field and diplomats in physiotherapy or other health courses.
- Build on current knowledge and skills increases in depth and complexity
- Essential development as a clinician and researcher
 - Clinical education and skills components
 - Development of core research skills

MSci Physiotherapy

- Module content:
 - Implementing evidence into practice
 - Interprofessional education
 - Learning and teaching in healthcare
 - Caseload management
 - Complex patient management
 - Health behaviour change
 - Leadership and management for healthcare professionals
 - Enhanced practice elective modules (x2)

MSc Physiotherapy

- Module content:
 - Leadership and service development
 - Advancing assessment and treatment skills
 - Interprofessional education
 - Health, wellbeing and behaviour change
 - Enhanced physiotherapy management of complex patients
 - Caseload evaluation

Clinical Placement Hours

- Currently minimum 1000 hours in United Kingdom (Health and Care Professionals Council (HCPC) registration)
 - MSci - 1380 clinical hours
 - MSc - 1240 clinical hours

Employability and Career Pathway

- Band 6 and Senior roles usually require an MSc

International Recognition

- Working abroad often requires Masters level qualification to register
- Currently pending Australian accreditation and Canadian competency profile approval
