Renewable energy generation begins on campus

Renewable energy generation is now underway at the new Low Carbon Energy Generation Park on the Keele University campus, marking an important milestone in Keele's journey to become carbon neutral by 2030.

Once fully completed, the Park, which features 12,500 solar photo-voltaic (PV) panels and two wind turbines, will generate up to 50% of the University's electricity requirements from renewable sources, saving around 1,500 tonnes of carbon emissions each year.


