Aim of the study	• To test a nurse-led review (INCLUDE) for people with inflammatory conditions such as rheumatoid arthritis, PMR and ankylosing spondylitis to look for other common health problems such as heart disease, mood problems and osteoporosis and signpost people to treatment or tests. How did we do this?	 4 GP Practices took part. People filled in 3 questionnaires at 0,3,6 months. In two GP practices people were invited to attend a review. Some people took part in an interview after the review about tell us more about what they thought of the review. 	
What did we find?	 333 patients filled in questionnaires. 169 patients attended a review. Other health problems were common (1 in 2 reported high blood pressure, 1 in 5 mood problems and 1 in 10 osteoporosis). Patients said the review was acceptable and helpful. People in the review practices were more likely to be receiving treatment for their other health problems at 12 months. 	Thankyou for taking part in the study!
