

Fire Escape Plan

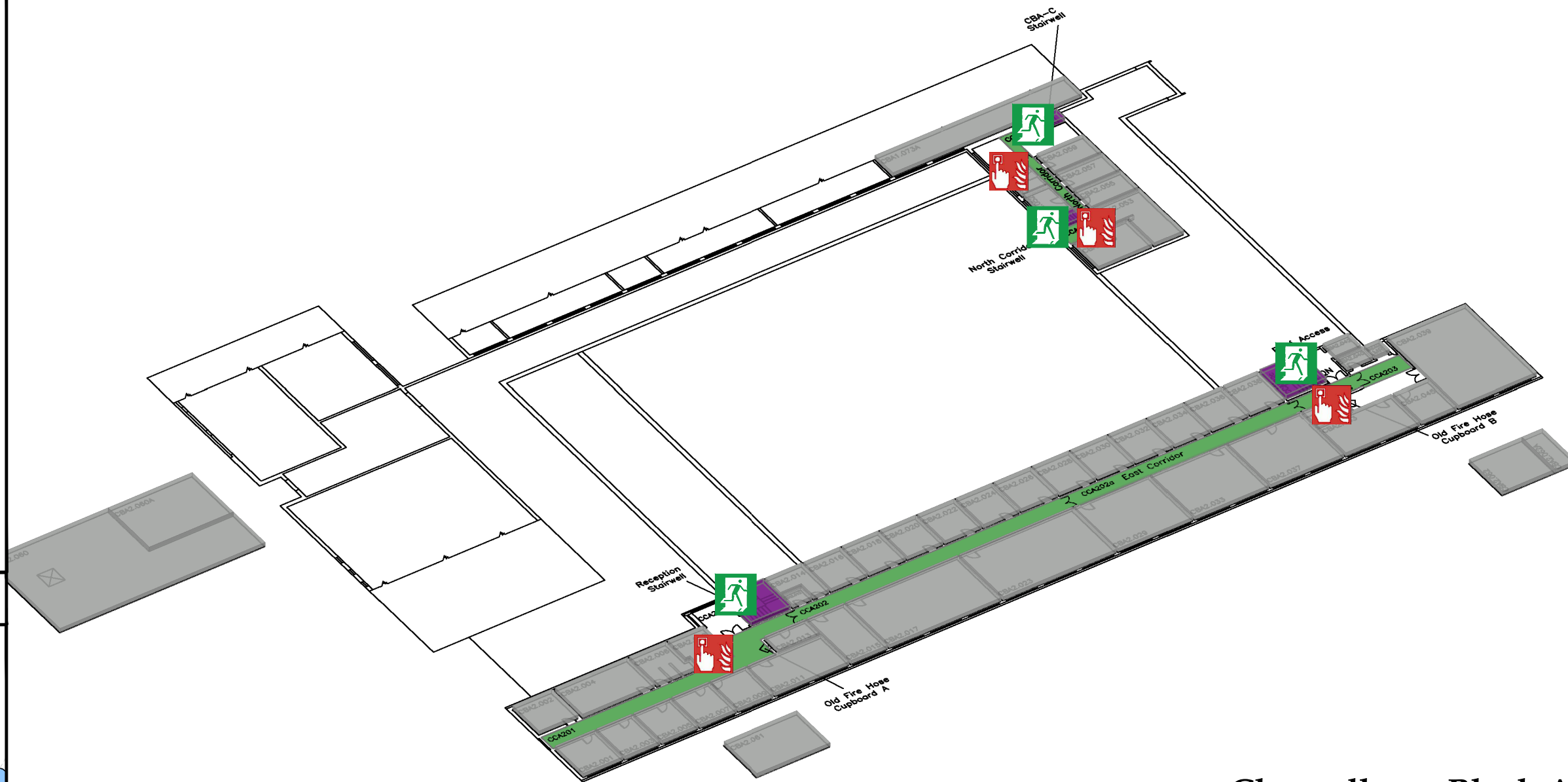
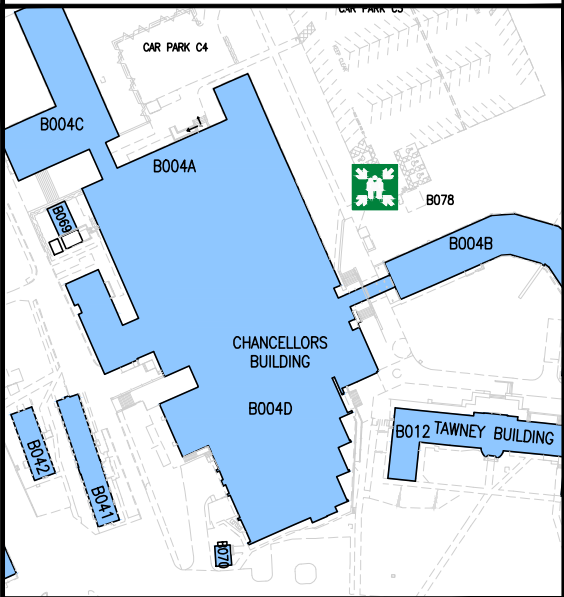
- For Fire Alarm:** Indicated by a "Fire alarm" icon (a hand pressing a button with flames). The instruction is "Sound the alarm by operating the fire alarm call point".

Following these initial actions, the flowchart provides common instructions for all:

- On activation of the fire alarm, you must leave the building immediately by the nearest safe available fire exit** (green box).
- Do not** (red box with a prohibition sign):
 - Do not take risks
 - Do not stop to collect personal belongings
 - Do not re-enter the building for any reason unless authorised to do so
- Report to the designated assembly point** (green box). The designated assembly point is specified as "Chancellors Car Park C" in a white box.
- Contact Campus Safety Team 01782 733999 to confirm a fire alarm activation** (red box).
