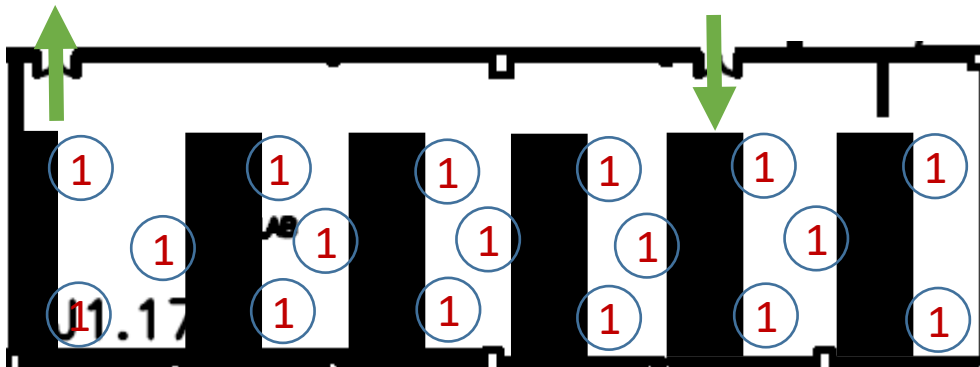


LJ1.17 Action Plan



LJ1.17 will be used solely by 3rd year Physics project students.

The maximum capacity is 18 people, with a maximum of 17 students and minimum 1 supervisor.

Students will be assigned their own workspace and should aim to spend the majority of their time in that work space and to minimize their circulation around the laboratory. A suggestion of how students could be positioned is labelled above however, other layouts are acceptable as long as a 2 m gap is maintained between all work areas.

In line with the university policy, students and staff will be expected to wear face masks and face shields at all times.

Access in and out of the lab is in line with the one-way system of the Lennard-Jones building and is labelled above.

The Lennard-Jones building will remain locked so access will be via a Keele Card.

Once in the building, all staff and students will be expected to observe the one-way system.

A hand sanitizer station will be positioned outside of the entrance to the lab.

Any equipment which is used by more than one person must be wiped down before and after use and cleaning products will be provided for this.

NB: the air handling system within this laboratory has been passed by the Keele University estates team as "Covid secure".
