

Keele University Assistive Listening Systems

Keele University has a number of learning spaces on campus equipped with Induction Loop systems. This list details equipped rooms on campus and the loop technology in use.

Type:

- **T** (Telecoil), hearing aid users switch aid to 'T' position to pick up audio
- **IR** (Infra-Red), user has to wear a receiver pack to pick up audio. The receiver pack can operate with a hearing aid or users can provide own headphones.

Room	Type	How to use
Westminster Theatre	T	Require speaker to use microphone or use lectern mics, User switches aid to T position. Users ideally need to be seated on the balcony or below the balcony for optimal quality
CBA0.060	T	Ceiling Mounted Microphone, User switches aid to T position
CBA0.061	T	Ceiling Mounted Microphone, User switches aid to T position
CBA1.102	T	Ceiling Mounted Microphone, User switches aid to T position
CBA1.103	T	Ceiling Mounted Microphone, User switches aid to T position
DH0.008	T	Lectern Mounted Microphone, User switches aid to T position
DH0.010	T	Ceiling Mounted Microphone, User switches aid to T position
DH0.021	IR	Require speaker to use microphone, User needs to wear an IR receiver
DH0.051	T	Ceiling Mounted Microphone, User switches aid to T position
Keele Hall Ballroom	IR	Require speaker to use microphone, User needs to wear an IR receiver
Chapel	T	Require speaker to use microphone, User switches aid to T position.
Flexible Learning Space (formerly CBA0.075A,B&C)	T	Require speaker to use microphone, User needs to wear an IR receiver
Cinema Room (Media Building)	T	Ceiling Mounted Microphone, User switches aid to T position
Weatherall Lecture Theatre	T	Require speaker to use microphone or use lectern mics, User switches aid to T position.
Darwin 028	IR	Require speaker to use microphone, User needs to wear an IR receiver
Wolfson Lecture Theatre	IR	Require speaker to use microphone, User needs to wear an IR receiver

IR receivers are located on or near to the lectern in each learning space, if you cannot locate a receiver please contact Audio Visual Services for assistance.

Audio Visual Services also have 3 portable induction loops which can be hired out by staff and students. To check availability and to make a booking please contact Audio Visual Services.

In addition to the list above, a significant number of other rooms are equipped with microphones (or the ability to plug in a microphone) which may be utilised for users with an auditory issue. Please contact Audio Visual Services should you require further information.
