## 2. Objective of the Workshop

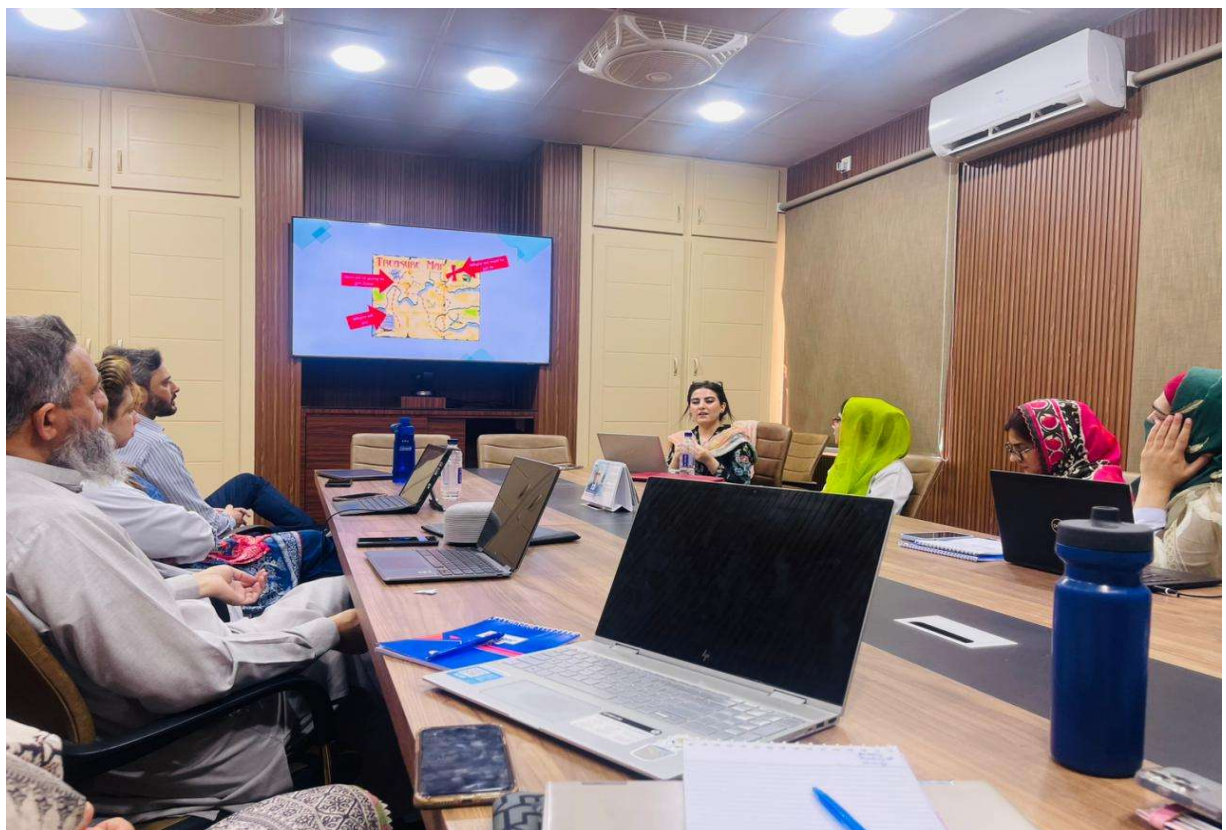
The workshop aimed to:
