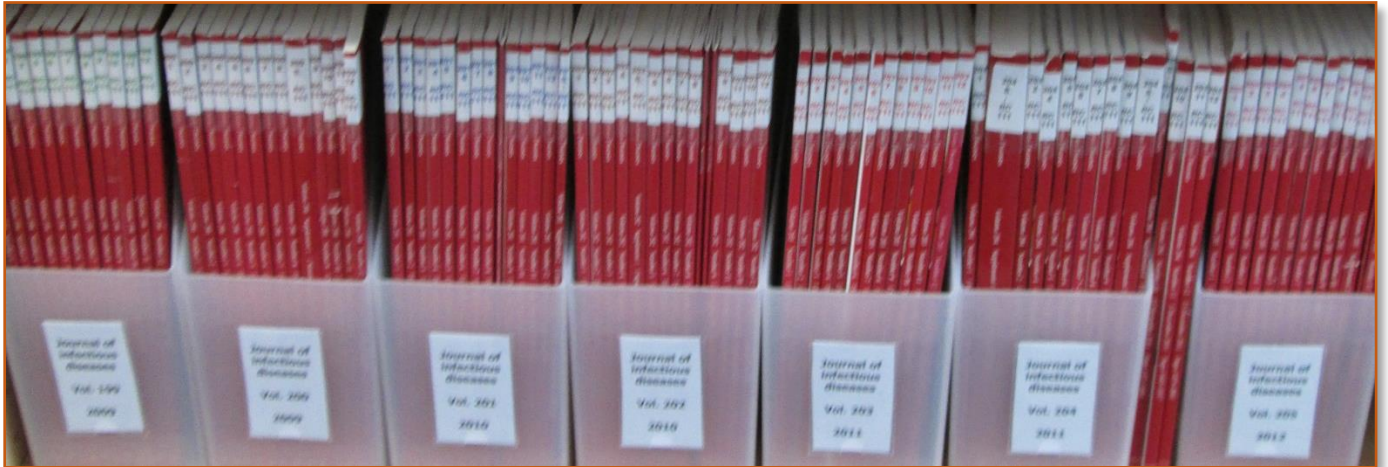


# NHS eJournals



## What is it?

eJournals are online electronic versions of journals, accessible via the Internet. They contain articles and published research and are usually issued on a regular basis throughout the year. Many journals are not freely available online. The Health Library and the NHS subscribe to eJournals on your behalf. Our eJournals collection is developed to support your learning, research and patient care.

## How to Access...

### Browse Journals using Browzine

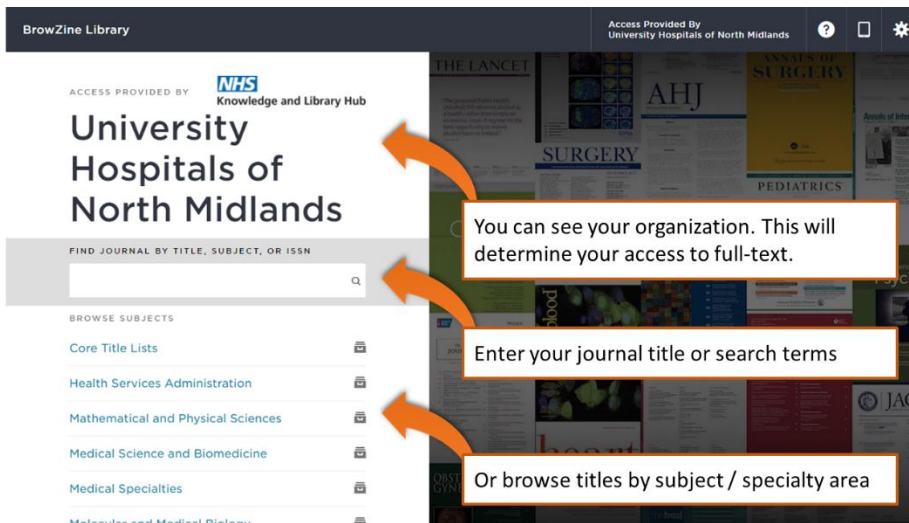
You can browse eJournals via **Browzine** - a third party tool provided by NHS England. No login is required to browse the list. Access to full-text articles will vary depending on your organisation. Select the right list from our journals page:

## Key Features

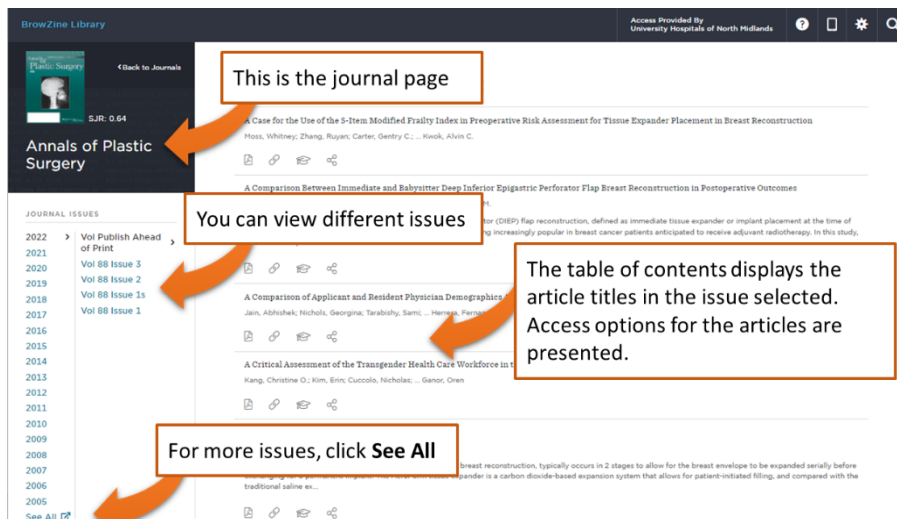
### Search for a Journal Title

Enter the title of the journal you are looking for into the text box or browse titles by subject / specialty area.



### View Journal page

The journal page presents you with **journal title**, **recent issues**, **table of contents**, **link to download the article pdf** (if available), **link to the article online html page** (if available), and **option to share the article link**.



### Access Full-Text

- Open access articles do not require a login.
- Subscribed articles need your NHS OpenAthens username to access full-text.
- Some articles will require you to make an article inter-library request.
