Who is it for?

OrthoEvidence is subscribed by the Health Library and is made available to library users who specialise in orthopaedics and physiotherapy.

Log in

OrthoEvidence is accessed by individual username / password. Contact the Health Library to request a username / password. This is NOT an OpenAthens authenticated resource.

Key Features

Browse Content on your dashboard

Set up your dashboard to include key topics you are interested in.



Search for content

Use the simple search box to look for content via the specialist database (note you may not necessarily be able to access full-text here).
