

Keele University Residential Carbon Emissions

At Keele we directly manage several Halls of Residence comprising more than 2,800 bedrooms. These are included within the University total scope 1 and 2 footprint and are managed through the Carbon Management Plan but are included here to show more detail of the sources of the campus carbon emissions. The total emissions for residential sources, as per the 2015/16 academic year show that 39.7% of the total campus scope 1 and 2 emissions are from residential sources.

In addition we have more than 100 domestic properties on campus many of which are available to staff to rent short term. These are considered to be scope 3 emissions as they are not under the direct control of the University.
