	It was noted that whilst the new Labour government		
	had not made any significant HE policy		
	announcements, it was clear they were more		
	supportive of the role of universities, the HE sector and		
	international students than experienced under the		
	previous government.

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	A new Student Services Hub had been created in the		
	Claus Moser Building to bring together all our student-		
	facing services. It would undoubtedly have a positive		
	impact on the student experience and was the first		
	stage of the capital redevelopment plan.

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	■ The University had submitted its Race Equality Charter		
	silver submission in July 2024 and further details would		
	be provided at the Joint Senate and Council meeting		
	following this meeting.		
	<ul> <li>Over the summer the University had made a</li> </ul>		
	submission to the Student Mental Health Charter. Its		
	aim was to support and encourage universities to		
	achieve a whole-organisation approach to mental		
	health and wellbeing.

	<ul> <li>The annual visit from Moody's Credit Rating took place</li> </ul>		
	on 7 <sup>th</sup> August 2024 and the rating remained unchanged		
	from last year at A1 stable.		
	■ The OfS had announced on 1 <sup>st</sup> August 2024 that a new		
	condition of registration on Harassment and Sexual		
	Misconduct would come into force on 1 <sup>st</sup> September		
	2025, with a requirement from 1 <sup>st</sup> September 2024 for		
	the use of non-disclosure agreements (NDAs) to be		
	banned where they covered allegations of harassment		
	or sexual misconduct. Council was assured that Keele		
	was already compliant with this requirement.		
	A further new condition of registration from the OfS		
	was anticipated regarding Freedom of Speech following		
	the royal assent of the HE Freedom of Speech Act but		
	the new government had announced its decision to		
	stop implementation of the remaining provisions in		
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	order to consider the approach it wished to take. The		
	University's Freedom of Expression Code of Practice		
	remained in place and continued to be operated in		
	both the University and the Students' Union.		
	The Graduation ceremonies in July 2024 had been a		
	great success with well over 2,000 students graduating		
	and the Vice-Chancellor thanked everyone who had		
	attended and been involved.		
	■ In April 2024, Dr Laura Rhodes joined Keele as our new		
	Head of Net Zero and Sustainability to drive		
	performance, awareness and impact in this strategically		
	important area for the University.		
	An update was also provided on various activities in the		
	sector.
