Student Experience and Support

All our students can access advice, guidance, and 1:1 support from our team of Student Experience and Support Officers (SESOs).

We have a dedicated SESO based within each academic School. Our SESOs are available if you need to talk to someone or need support, whether it's about your studies or life outside of them.

We also have specific support available for students from our key student groups, including:



- Asylum seekers
- Care leavers and estranged students
 - LGBT+ students
- Mature students (over 21) and students under 18
- Students with parental or caring responsibilities

Counselling and Mental Health



Our Counselling and Mental Health team are a multidisciplinary team who can offer a wide range of interventions and various levels of support:

- In-house support as well as links with local NHS services
- Offer regular development workshops such as assertiveness, mindfulness and time management
- Coordinate a team of Peer Supporters a group of trained student volunteers who can offer confidential mental health support to their fellow students

Out of Hours Support



We have a range of out of hours support available to students during nights and weekends:

- Keele Campus Safety (24 hour)
- SafeZone app (24 hour)
- Spectrum.Life Student Assistance
 Programme (24 hour confidential helpline)

SafeZone App

- Ree safety app for students
- One-tap help: Call security, first aid, or emergency services
- Check-in: Let security know you're studying/working alone
- Fast response: Security can find you quickly
- Download free: App Store / Google Play (use uni email)



Disability Support and Inclusion



Our Disability Support and Inclusion (DSI) team can provide you with the individual support you need whilst at Keele:

- Accommodation e.g. adapted rooms, familiarisation visits
- Disabled Students' Allowance
- Referral for assessment for dyslexia and other learning difficulties
- Assessment of support needs
- Support staff within Schools e.g. Disability Inclusion Tutors
 - Reasonable adjustments e.g. personal exam

Chaplaincy



Within our Chaplaincy team, we have chaplains and faith advisers from some of the major religions who can offer support and guidance to those of all faiths and none.

We have dedicated places on campus for groups or individuals to worship, pray, meditate or reflect, and all students are welcome to make use of them:

Financial Support

Our Financial Support team offer confidential, non-judgmental advice and guidance about a variety of financial issues, including:

We also offer a range of pro-active campaigns and initiatives including Money Masterclasses, 1-2-1 Financial Wellbeing Checks and interactive awareness campaigns.


