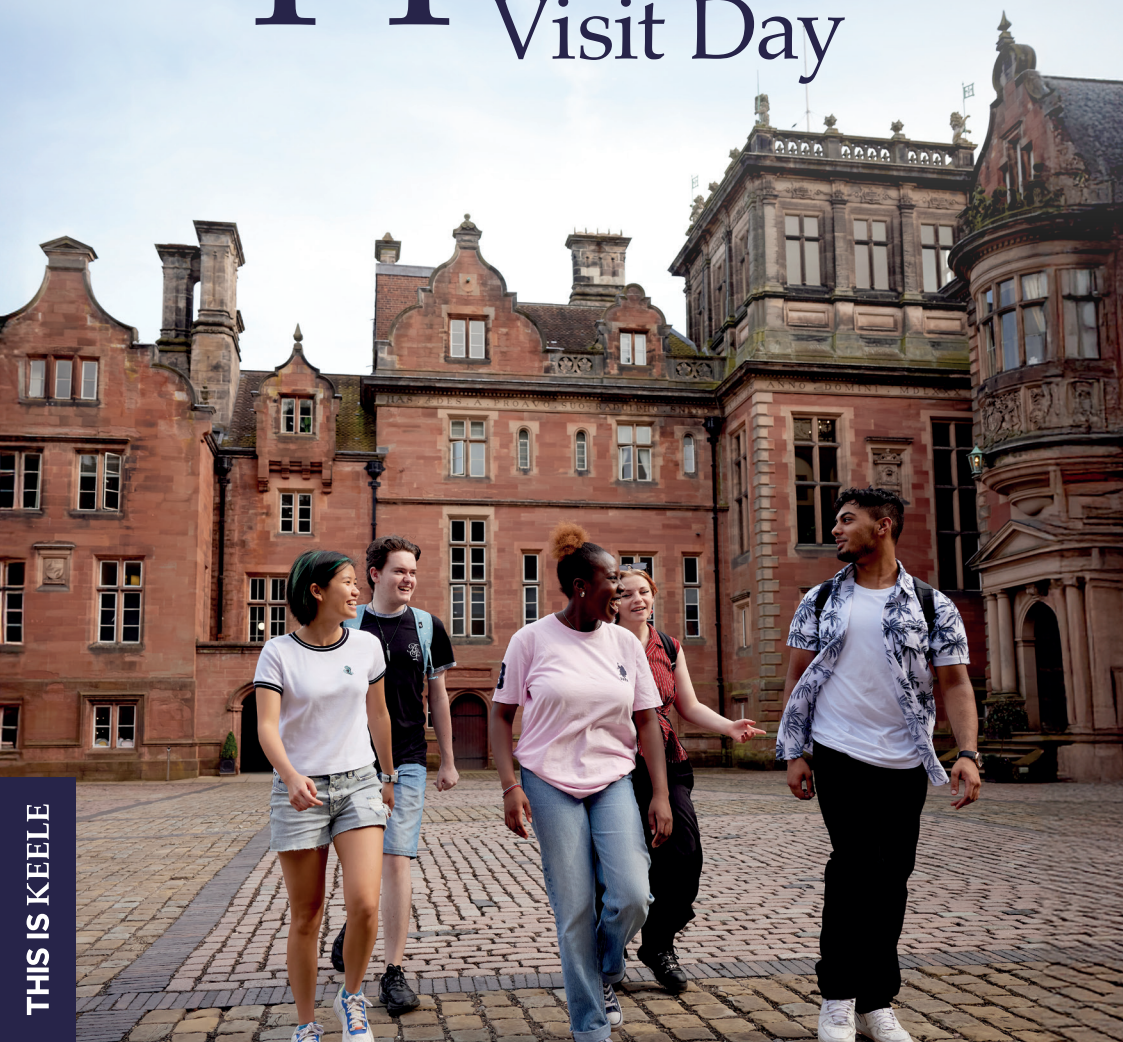

Sports CENTRE

Whether you are eligible for our Talented Athlete Programme, looking to join a club or just keep fit and healthy, we have lots on offer.



On-campus LIBRARY

Our on campus library offers fantastic facilities and a range of different study environments. Usually open 24/7 during term time it is also home to Careers and Employability. Keele HALL

The Hall has a long and colourful history; it provided a home and a place of exile for a Russian Grand Duke in the early 1900s and was requisitioned by the army during World War II.

It is now used extensively for conferences, University events and activities, is home to the Institute of Liberal Arts and Sciences, and provides a spectacular venue for weddings.

Take a BREAK

Grab a coffee and a bite to eat in The Kitchen Table and social space.



Student ALLOTMENTS

Feeling green-thumbed? Visit our student allotments (between Keele Hall and Lindsay Hall) and see where our students grow their own vegetables.



Woodland WALKS

Explore our three woodland and lake walks starting by Keele Hall, including an all-weather trail suitable for wheelchair users. Two trails are over uneven terrain so suitable footwear is advised. Please take care by open water.



Low Carbon ENERGY PARK

You won't spot this from the centre of campus, but just past the Science and Innovation Park is our Low Carbon Energy Park, which is home to 12,500 solar panels and 2 wind turbines – generating 50% of our electricity requirements!



Explore beyond Keele

If you're here for a little longer, why not explore the local area?

Newcastle-under-Lyme, the closest town to campus, offers a student-friendly high street with plenty of eateries, bars, a cinema and four big supermarkets within walking distance of the bus station.

Stoke-on-Trent is home to The Potteries Centre, a cinema and theatres, nightlife and food outlets; there's plenty to see and do!





State-of-the-art FACILITIES
