You can access content by either browsing through the sections – procedures, chapters and illustrations – or by entering your search terms into the search box.

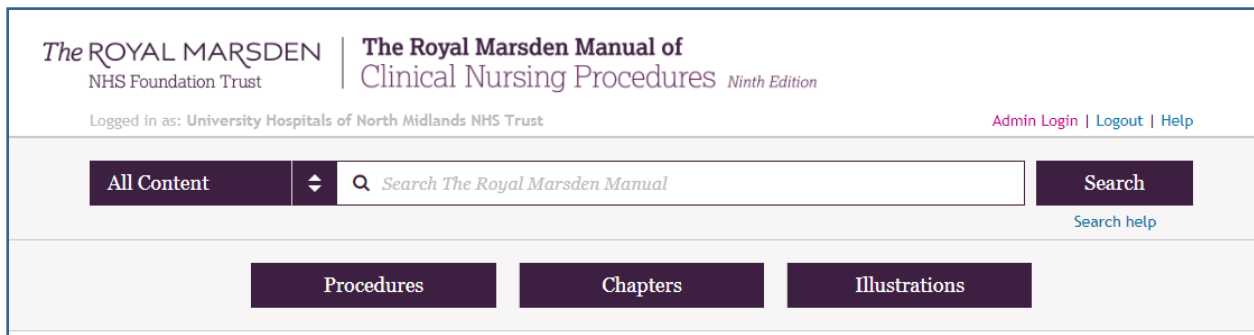


Figure 1 Screen-shot of the home page for the Royal Marsden Manual Online

Procedures

You can access all the procedures via the A-Z list.

Chapters

Content is organised into chapters. You can jump to any chapter or sub-chapter. The main chapters are:

- Managing the Patient Journey
- Supporting the Patient with Human Functioning
- Supporting the Patient through the Diagnostic Process
- Supporting the Patient through Treatment

Illustrations

You can look specifically for illustrations by clicking the illustrations tab. Clicking the sub-chapter heading will present the images it contains.

Evidence-Based

You can view the reference of the evidence for chapters by looking in the references section, or for procedures by clicking the text “Show rationale for all steps”.
