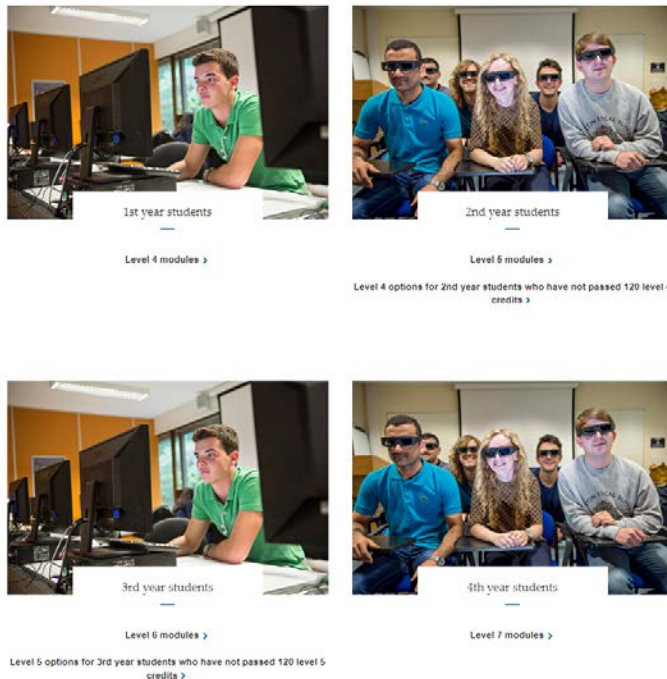


HOW TO..... register your module choices on eVision

We recommend that you thoroughly research your modules in advance.

You can do this as follows:

- Go to the [modules homepage](#)
- Select 'Module Selection' from the menu and this screen will appear:



Click on the appropriate level of study for you

The modules that you will study will depend upon the degree you are taking.

To find out which modules you have to take and what option choices you may have, please select your degree programme from the dropdown lists.

If you are an **international student** and not a native speaker of English, or have received your education in a language other than English, you will be pre-allocated to an **English for Academic Purposes (EAP) module** as one of your optional modules, pending the results of the Induction Week Language Assessment. Keele's EAP modules help you build the academic English skills that you will depend on for success with your degree studies.

Opting Out

Thinking of opting out of Global Challenge Pathways?

- If you opt out of a GCP at any level, you cannot choose a GCP module later in your degree programme or choose to opt back in
- To study a GCP and obtain certification, you must study a GCP module (from a single pathway) at levels 4, 5 and 6

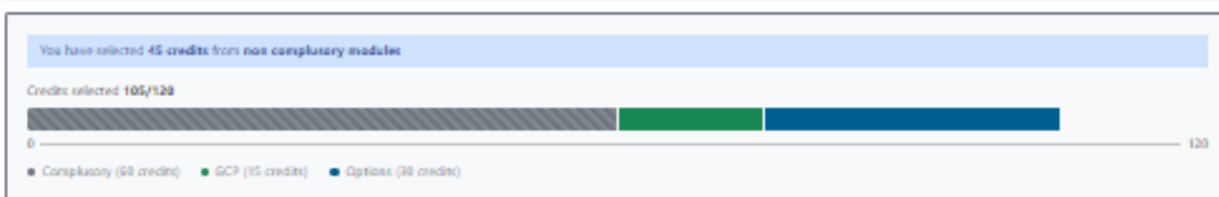

Sometimes a module also has a pre-requisite which can be an A-level, some other previous experience / qualification or a module studied at Keele at a previous level.

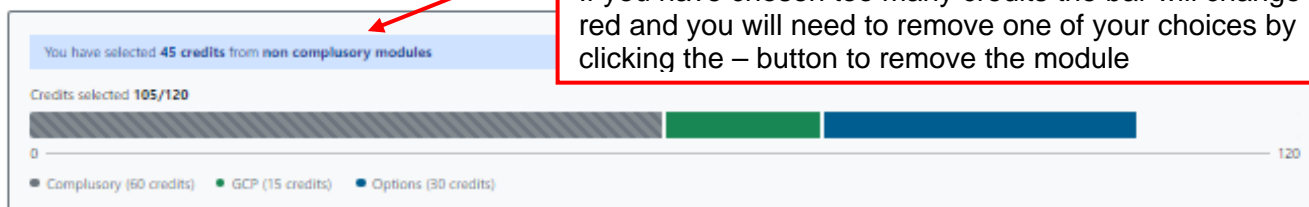
If you choose a module and it is later discovered that you don't have the necessary pre-requisite, you will be removed from that module and asked to choose an alternative.

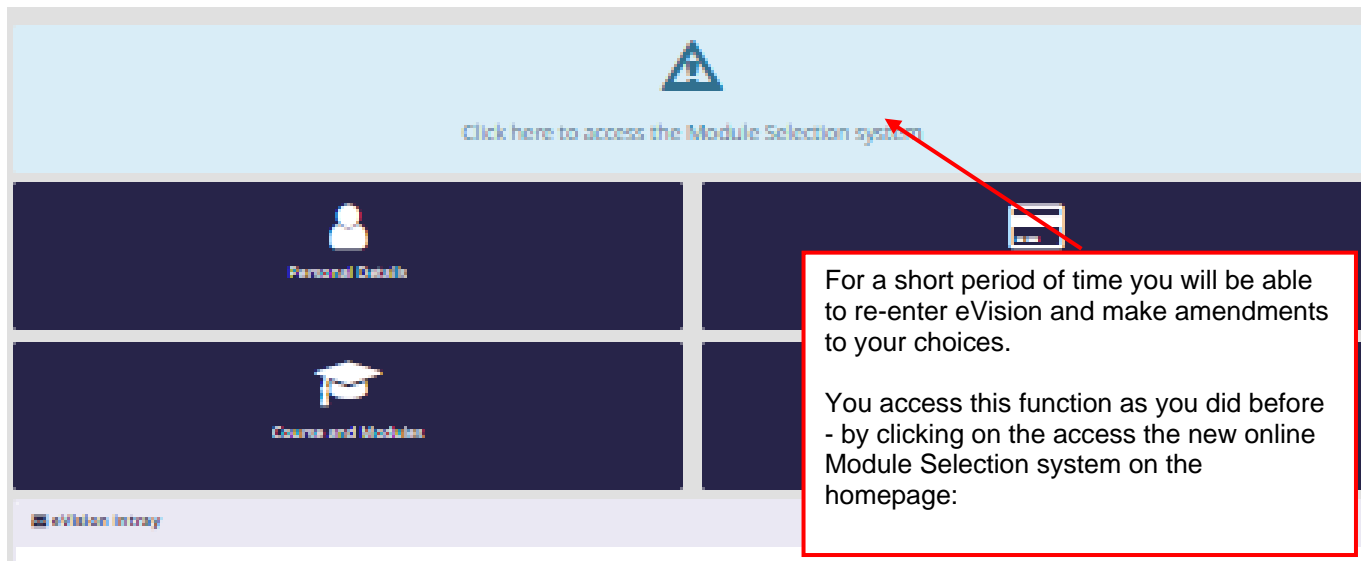

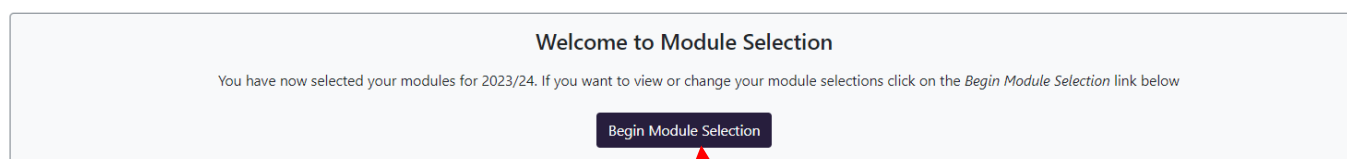
